Grab 'n Go Bags

Have a Grab 'n Go Bag for each person in the house





- o Flashlight, batteries, and light sticks
- o Portable radio and batteries
- o Keys (house and car)
- o Money (coins and bills)
- o Glasses, contacts lenses and solutions
- o Medications (at least one-week supply)
- o Specialized medications (allergies, etc)
- o Comfortable clothing (sweats, extra underwear)
- o Jacket, cap or hat
- o Comfortable shoes, two pairs of socks
- o Pocket knife
- o Watch or clock
- o Paper and pencil
- o Whistle (call for help if trapped)
- o Emergency phone list, out-of-state contact #
- o Lists of people to notify if you are injured
- o Copies of important documents: Insurance, Identification, social security, etc. (Med Forms)
- o First aid kit (extra bandages, gauze, band-aids)
- o Sunscreen
- o Insect Repellant

Adults

- o Toiletries: comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, washcloth, face towel, shampoo, lotion, razor, lip balm, emery board, nail clipper, sanitary products, tissues, wet wipes, deodorant, etc.
- o Toilet paper and trash bags
- o Zip-lock bags, plastic grocery bags
- o Good book, playing cards, crossword puzzles
- o Current photo of family and pets
- o Blanket (emergency and warm ones)
- o Work gloves, several pairs of nitrile gloves
- o Emergency tent and/or ground cloth
- o Hard hat
- o Dust mask that fits to face (two)
- o Hammer, folding shovel, crowbar
- o Rope and duct tape
- o Eating utensils and bowls
- Drinking water store in a separate place (minimum one gallon per person per day)
- o Food (stable, canned with can opener)
- o Snacks (granola bars, trailmix, nuts)



Senior or Disabled

These items are in addition to the Adult Grab 'n Go Bag

- o Food for special diet needs
- o Batteries for hearing aids, wheelchair, etc.
- o List of style and serial # of medical devices
- o Special supplies: oxygen, catheters, etc.
- o Extra warm clothes, sox, hat, gloves, shoes
- Prescriptions for eyeglasses (most current, preferably within one year)
- Personal sanitary items, incontinence pads and/or pants
- o For guide dogs, see Pet Grab 'n Go Bag



Infants and Toddlers

These items are in addition to the Adult Grab 'n Go Bag

- o Formula, disposable bottles, nipples
- o Diapers, disposable pants and wipes
- o Instant baby cereal
- o Bowl and spoon
- o Sunscreen and insect repellant
- o At least two changes of clothes
- o Light jacket and hat
- o Current photo of whole family & pets

- o Thermometer
- o Medicine dropper or syringe
- o Pedialyte, electrolyte replacement solution
- o Tylenol, Triaminic and other medications
- o Firm soled slippers or shoes
- o Toys, books, stuffed animals, blanket
- Authorization to Consent to Treatment of Minor Form, completed

Pets

Keep your Pet Grab 'n Go Bag in an easily accessible location near your own emergency supplies



- o Food
- o Water
- o Bowls
- o Leash or lead
- o Muzzle
- o Poop scooper, bags
- o Treats and Toys
- o Blanket/Bedding
- Clumping Cat Litter

- Pet First Aid Kit
- o Scissors
- o Gauze pads
- o Wipes
- o Instant cold pack
- o Adhesive tape
- o Rolled bandages
- o Tweezers
- o Soap

- ... o Extra name tag
- ... o License number
- ... o Pet carrier or crate for each pet (keep near the bag)
- ... o Name, address and phone number of veterinarian
- ... o Vaccination and medical records
- ... o Allergy or other special instructions

Car Emergency Kit

- o Water
- o Food (canned, dehydrated, snacks)
- o Sweater or jacket, extra clothing
- o Comfortable walking shoes and socks
- o Money (coins and bills)
- o Flashlight (and extra batteries)
- o Space blanket and a soft blanket
- o First Aid Kit (bandages, gauze, etc.)
- o Pocket Knife
- o Matches (waterproof)
- o Flares
- o Fire extinguisher
- o Work gloves
- o Jumper cables
- o Pencil and paper
- o Tools (screwdriver, pliers, wire, crowbar, rope, etc.)
- o Emergency phone numbers, including your contact person
- o Maps of your most often traveled routes
- o Personal items: such as eyeglasses, toothbrush and toothpaste, hand sanitizers, tissues, wet wipes, toilet tissue, hand lotion
- o Special needs: medication (such as antihistamine), diapers, infant formula, etc.
- o Something to do: book, crossword puzzles or games
- o Current photo of family and pets
- o Add pet items if your pet travels with you
